MEMORANDUM OF ASSOCIATION

Name of the society : Himalaya Educational Society
Address of the office of the Society : H.No.1-5-52,Ram Nagar,Hyderabad-500048

AIMS AND OBJECTS OF THE SOCIETY

1. To establish and run the Society as a non-profit educational Organisation.
2. To undertake, provide, assist, in all kinds of educational services by setting up schools/colleges and institutions or by any other mode.
3. To provide or to encourage, initiate or promote facilities for improvement or development of new methods of educational understanding from time to time.
4. To acquire, manage, administer and run all types of laboratories and import all types of equipments to educate, train and to establish Colleges. Schools and connected educational facilities".
5. Offering software development training, IT Enable training, Computer networking, call centre, data processing, Medical / legal transcription, business out sourcing, business developments training in the field of trade, commerce and Industry.
6. To print, publish, exhibit, subscribe and support periodicals, books, posters that may be considered desirable for the promotion of the objectives of the society without any profit motive.
7. To establish, promote and provide accommodation to the students and learners without any profit motive.
8. To establish a library and keep it up to date from time to time for enabling the society to promote its objectives.
9. To conduct conferences, refresher courses, lectures, seminars, demonstrations and exhibits relating to the research done, knowledge generated and results obtained.

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10. To promote, develop and improve scientific exchange of knowledge as well as technical co-operation between other similar institutions in India or overseas with similar interests and objective.
11. To provide, institute recognition of attainment, fellowships or scholarships, stipends, awards, prizes, grant diplomas in the areas of concerned interests to the Society.
12. To provide/institute recognition of attainment, fellowships or scholarships, stipends, awards, prizes, remunerations and / or other similar payments to facilitate undertaking scientific research in the areas of concerned interests to the Society.

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DOCUMENT NO. II

RULES & REGULATIONS

Name of the society : Himalaya Educational Society

Address of the office of the Society : H.No.1-9-52, Ram Nagar, Hyderabad-500048.

DEFINITIONS

1. The marginal notes here not effect the construction hereof and in these presents unless is something in the subject of context inconsistent therewith.

“The Society” means “Himalaya Educational Society”

“Accounting Year” means period commencing from April 01 and ending on March 31 of every year unless otherwise decided by the governing Council.

“The Act” means the Andhra Pradesh Societies Registration Act, 2001

The “Chairman” means a person elected as such at the General Body Meeting of Society for the time being.

The “Vice-Chairman” means a person elected as such at the General Body Meeting of Society for the time being.

The “Governing Council” means the Board of Governors for time being of the Society.

“Office” means the Registered Office of the Society.

“Person” means any individual and shall include a Trust. Body Corporate. Society or other organisations (Whether incorporated or not).

“Members” shall mean the Members of the Society.

Words importing singular number only include plural number and Vice-Versa. Words importing masculine gender only include feminine gender or a body corporation or other organisation.

MEMBERS

2. The Society shall consist of not less than seven members. The following Persons shall be members of the Society namely:

a) The subscribers to the Memorandum of Association of the Society.

b) All persons/bodies corporate, trusts. Societies and companies as may be admitted as members of the Society.

The Governing Council shall be empowered to create various types of memberships. Sponsors, associates etc., and also admit new members at their sole discretion with such voting rights as it defines and decides.

c) The Society may also have Founder / Special Sponsors and Founder / Special / Associates who can be admitted by the Governing Council under such rights and privileges as the Governing Council may decide from time to time.

d)

I]. Applications for membership shall be made in such form as the Governing Council from time to time prescribe and the Governing Council shall advise the applicant of the acceptance or rejection but shall not be bound to assign any reason therefore.

II] The decision of the Governing Council as to the eligibility of a person for membership of the Society or to a class of membership shall be final and conclusive.

GENERAL MEETINGS

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS

3. As Annual General Meeting of the Society shall be convened and held within Six months of the end of the Accounting year of the Society at such place and on such date and at such time as shall be determined by the Governing Council.

BUSINESS OF ANNUAL GENERAL MEETINGS

4. The purpose of the Annual General Meeting shall be to.
- receive consider and adopt the Annual Accounts of the society and report of the general Council and auditors thereon.
 - elect the members of the Governing Council.
 - appoint an auditor to audit the accounts of the Society for the ensuing year.
 - transact any other business

EXTRA-ORDINARY GENERAL MEETINGS

- 5.
- An Extra-ordinary General Meeting of the Society may be convened at any time by the Governing Council or the Chairman for the transaction of any special business.

- b. The Governing Council shall call an Extra-ordinary General Meeting, on a requisition in writing by at least 50% of the members of the Society existing on the date of the requisition stating the object of the meeting and the text of the resolutions to be moved there at The business of such Extra-ordinary general Meeting shall be confined to the business for which it has been convened and such Extra-Ordinary General Meeting shall not transact any other business.

NOTICE OF MEETING

6. Fourteen days notice specifying the place, day and hour of the meeting and the agenda of the business to be transacted at the meeting shall be sent to each member in respect to each of the General Meeting of the Society.

Provided that the non-receipt of such notice by any member shall not invalidate any resolution passed by or proceedings of a meeting. Any meeting may be held on shorter notice than the one specified above, if more than one half of the members of the Society agree in writing to such shorter notice.

SERVICE OF THE NOTICE

7. Service of the notice shall be deemed to have been effected in due course if the same is posted under certificate of posting. This however, does not preclude notice being served by Telex or Telegram or Cable or any other electronic mode.

CHAIRMAN OF THE GENERAL MEETING

8. The Chairman of the Governing Council shall preside at every General Meeting. In the absence of the Chairman, the members present may elect one of the members of the Governing Council who are present to be the Chairman. In the absence of all the members of Governing Council, the meeting shall come to a close, without transacting any business.

POWER TO ADJOURN GENERAL MEETING

9. The chairman of the meeting may on his own motion or with the consent of a majority of the members present adjourn any meeting, but no business shall be transacted at an adjourned meeting other than the business left unfinished at the meeting.

QUORUM

10. For any General Meeting, the Quorum shall be four members present in person and one of whom must be a member of the Governing Council.



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WHEN QUORUM NOT PRESENT MEETING TO BE ADJOURNED

11. In the case of an Annual General Meeting, if within half an hour from the time appointed for holding the meeting, there is no quorum the meeting shall stand adjourned to the same day of the following week at the same time and place where the meeting is concerned and if at such adjourned meeting a quorum is not present within half an hour from the time appointed for holding the meeting, the members present shall constitute the quorum. In the case of Special General Meeting, if there is no quorum the meeting shall stand dissolved

CASTING VOTE

12. Every question submitted to a meeting shall be decided by show of hands and in case of equality of votes the Chairman of the Meeting shall have a casting vote in addition to the vote to which he is entitled to as a member.

VOTE OF MEMBERS

VOTING RIGHTS

13. Every resolution submitted to the meeting shall be decided by a show of hands unless a poll is demanded; the members or the Chairman shall be entitled to demand a poll. In the case of equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a casting vote in addition to his own vote.

ADMINISTRATION

GOVERNING COUNCIL

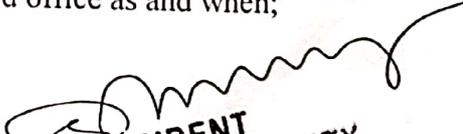
14. The society shall be administered and managed by its Governing Council, which shall have all the authority and power to administer and manage the affairs of the Society.

GOVERNING COUNCIL

COMPOSITION

15.
 - I] The Governing Council shall consist of not more than 7 members of whom one will be Chairman, Vice Chairman, Secretary, Joint Secretary Treasurer, and other members.
 - II] Not less than one third of the members of the Governing Council including the Chairman shall retire at every Annual General Meeting who shall be eligible to be re-nominated.
 - III] A member of the Governing Council shall cease to hold office as and when;

- a. He resigns by a letter in writing addressed to the Society.
- b. Tie is declared insolvent
- c. He is found guilty of moral turpitude by a competent Court.
- d. He is of unsound mind.
- e. He does not attend three consecutive meetings being in Hyderabad and without seeking or obtaining leave of absence from the Governing Council

- a. The Governing Council shall have the power to function notwithstanding any vacancy in their Body The Governing Council shall be empowered to co-opt, members on the Council who shall be eligible for election at the next Annual General Meeting.
- b. Three members of the Governing Council present will constitute the quorum for a meeting of the Governing Council and decision of the majority shall be deemed to be the decision of the Governing Council. Each member of the Governing Council shall have a vote and in the case of equality of votes, the Chairman shall have a casting vote in addition.
- c. A meeting of the Governing Council for the time being at which a quorum is present shall be competent to exercise all or any of the powers vested in or exercisable by the Governing Council generally.
- d. Meetings of the Governing Council may be held at such place, date and time as may be decided by the Chairman, except for emergency meetings, seven days notice shall be given for each meeting. However, members residing outside India shall receive adequate notice so that, the meeting is scheduled seven Clays from the date of receipt of the notice.
- e. The Governing Council may take decisions by affixing their signatures to resolutions circulated to the members of the Governing Council and a decision taken by the majority of the members in such manner shall be deemed to be a decision taken at a meeting of the Governing Council.

POWER OF THE GOVERNING COUNCIL

The Society shall be administered and managed by its Governing Council, which shall have all the authority and power to administer and manage the affairs of the Society. The Governing Council shall have the authority to appoint Committees with such terms of reference and delegated powers as the Governing Council considers explicit and necessary for the purpose of managing and administering the Societies affairs.

Without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, the Governing Council shall have the following powers.

- i). To institute and to Create Post and to employ Officers, Workers, Contractors and others as and when necessary on salary, allowance, honorarium or wages or piece rate remuneration on whole or part time or casual basis.
- ii). To award Diplomas, Certificates and other Distinctions to Candidates trained and to prescribe standards of proficiency before the award of such Diplomas, Certificates and other Distinctions.
- iii). To acquire, build, hire. Maintain hospitals. Dispensaries, clinics, laboratories, diagnostic centres etc and related facilities and equip them with amenities considered necessary for the proper discharge of the functions of the Society. To acquire, obtain, import all kinds of instruments, books, medicines, drugs, injections, clinical pharmaceutical equipments for treatment, progress of any disease, diagnosis, prevention of diseased or ailing person, animal, birds etc.
- iv). To obtain aid, contributions, endowments, donations grants, subscriptions from various sources, including government, semi-government organisations, public limited companies, Government Corporation, individuals and other Societies, Institutions both from within and outside the country.
- v). To acquire, purchase in whatever manner possible for carrying on the aims and object of the Society and for the said purpose to receive gifts, endowments, grants, land leases from other Societies, the Government, individuals, public, private or Government Companies, Partnerships and trusts, charitable or otherwise or obtain the same by purchase, lease, or by any other means permissible under the law and to lease out or sell or otherwise transfer any of its property to subserve the purposes of the Society.
- vi). To build residential accommodation including hostels for carrying on the aims and objects of the Society.
- vii). To sell, improve, manage, develop land, building or make alterations or improvements, exchange, lease, mortgage, give or take for free use, dispose off turn to account or otherwise deal with all or any part of the property and rights of the Society.



- viii). To develop lands and to construct, build, alter or demolish roads, drains, buildings, structures and other works.
- ix). To establish, maintain, use, administer and participate in any activity towards the achievement of its objects.
- x). To invest and deal with funds and properties of the Society in such manner as may from to time be determined and to vary or dispose off any such investments in accordance with the provisions of the Income- Tax Act, 1961, if any, mandatarily applicable.
- xi). The Governing Council shall be authorised to open the Accounts of Society in any Bank(s) as may be decided by them and to operate the said Account/accounts in such manner as may be decided by them from time to time.
- xii). To draw, make, accept, discount, endorse, negotiate, buy, sell, execute and issue bills of exchange and other Promissory Notes, Cheques, Warrants, Debentures and other negotiable or transferable instruments or Securities.
- xiii). To accept endowments, gifts and donations, including gifts or donations subject to conditions, fees, block grants, rents and other dividend and payments in lieu of goods or services rendered.
- xiv). To offer Research/or consultancy services in any area connected with the aims and objects of the Society or through other institutions which may be established, owned, or managed by the Society as a non-profit organisation.
- xv). To receive security deposits in cash or otherwise in connection with activities of the Society.
- xvi). To incur expenditure and make all necessary financial arrangements for carrying on the work of the Society.
- xvii). To borrow or raise or secure funds and properties on security or otherwise from time to time for the purpose of the Society upon such terms as may be deemed reasonable or fit by the Governing Council.
- xviii). To establish, maintain, or continue one or more provident funds or superannuation funds or similar funds for the benefit of the employees of the Society and to give donations, gratuities, pensions, or allowances to any person who are or were at any time employees of the Society or their families or dependents.
- xix). To canyon any kind of activity which is necessary or conducive to the attainment of the objects of the Society or any of them.

- xx). The Governing Council shall appoint such honorary and stipendiary Office bearers as may be deemed necessary from time to time and may assign such functions to them as may be considered expedient.
- xxi). The Governing Council shall have full control of employees and administration of the Society and its constituents with full right to delegate any of its powers.
- xxii). Do all acts, matters and things as are incident or conducive to the attainment of the above aims and objectives or anyone more of them.
- xxiii). To amalgamate with any society having objects altogether or in part similar to those of this society and also to divide the societies' divisions into two or more societies.

FUNCTIONS

Chairman

- 19. a) The Chairman of the Governing Council shall:
 - i) Supervise all the activities of the Society: including the expenditure, subject to the provisions of the budget;
 - ii) Sign the minutes of the meeting.
 - iii) Arrange to convene the meeting of the Governing Council
- b) In addition to his voting right as a member of the Governing Council, Chairman shall have a casting vote in case of equality of votes.

Vice Chairman

- 20. Two Vice-chairman shall assist the chairman in discharging his functions. In the absence of the chairman, they shall perform the duties of the chairman as entrusted by him.

Executive Secretary

The executive Secretary shall do work entrusted by the Governing Council or the General Secretary. In the absence of General Secretary, the Executive Secretary.

- 21. Secretary

The Secretary shall do work entrusted by the Governing Council or the Executive Secretary in the absence of Executive Secretary the Secretary may perform the duties of the Executive Secretary.

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22. Joint Secretary

The Joint secretary shall do all work as entrusted by the Governing Council and shall assist the Executive Secretary in discharging his duties. In the absence of the Executive Secretary, he may perform the duties of the Executive Secretary.

23. Treasurer

The Treasurer shall be responsible for all financial transactions relating to the society. The Treasurer shall prepare the Budget Expenditure Statement of the Society.

LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

24. The Society may sue or be sued on behalf of or against the Society. All applicants be made and taken in the name of the Executive Secretary / Secretary of the Governing Council unless any other person has been nominated by the Governing Council for the purposes.

SEAL

25. The seal of the Society shall not be used except on a resolution of the Governing Council. A Document which bears the seal of the Society shall be signed on behalf of the Society by the Chairman or a member of the Governing Council duly authorised.

FUNDS

26. All funds of the Society shall be dealt with appropriately as may be authorised by the Governing Council or a duly authorised Committee/Office Bearers appointed by the Governing Council.
27. The Governing Council shall have the right of management of the funds of the Society and shall have power to incur such expenditure including delegated powers to Committee / Office Bearers as it may and think necessary and proper in the interest of the Society.
28. The Income and property of the Society howsoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the Society as set forth in the Memorandum of the Society and no portion thereof shall be dealt with or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus or otherwise provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment of remuneration, travelling and/or otherwise allowances to any employee of the Society, delegate or invite or to any member thereof or other person in consideration of services actually rendered to the Society.
29. If upon the dissolution of the society the remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed

amongst the members of the Society or any of them, but shall be given or transferred to sonic Society or Societies with aims and objects similar to this Society.

ACCO U N T S

30. The Governing Council shall ensure true accounts to be kept of all sums of money received and expended by the Society and of all matters in respect of which such receipts and expenditure takes place and of the assets credits and liabilities of the Society The accounting year of Society shall be from 1st January to 31st December unless otherwise determined by the Governing Council.
31. The account of the Society shall be audited once in each year by such qualified person or persons as may be appointed by the Members at the Annual General Meeting. The first Auditors may be appointed by the Governing Council.
32. The Governing Council shall cause to be filed with the Registrar appointed under the Public Societies Registration Act, 1350F once in every year or before the 14th day of succeeding the day on which the Annual General Meeting of the Society is held and list of the names, addresses and occupations of the members of the Governing Council should be filed with the Registrar.

BYE-LAWS

33. The Governing Council shall have power to make bye-laws for the conduct and governance of the Society and for the governance of the Councils, Officers and Agents of the Society or for any other purposes whatsoever provided that such bye- laws are not in conflict with these rules and regulations.

AMENDMENTS

34. The foregoing rules and regulations shall be copied in a book to be kept with the Records of the Society. Printed/Cyclostyled Copies of the same shall be forwarded to all the members and no alteration or addition shall be made therein or thereto save and except when it is proposed by a majority of two thirds of the members of the Society at a General Meeting specially convened for the purpose by a notice issued at least ten days before the holding of such a meeting specially and in which all the terms proposed alternations or additions shall have been clearly set forth, and shall be confirmed by the majority of two third members of the Society at subsequent General meeting specially convened in the manner as the initial meeting as aforesaid.

DISSOLUTION

35. (a). The society may, by passing a special resolution, determine that it shall be dissolved of and thereupon, with prior intimation to the Registrar, it shall be dissolved at the time specified in the resolution and all the necessary steps shall be taken for the disposal and settlement of the property of the society, and its claims and liabilities according to the

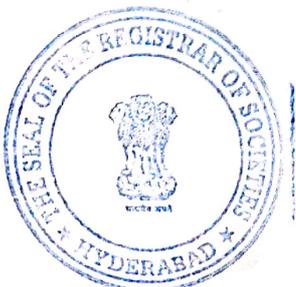
bye-law of the society and if there are no bye-laws to this effect in the manner as the General Body may find it expedient.

(b). Provided that in the event of any dispute arising among the members of the Governing Council or the members of the society, the adjustment of its affairs shall be referred to the court and the court shall make such order in the manner including appointment of liquidator as it deems fit.

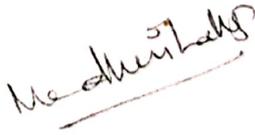
(c). The Society dissolved under this section shall file with the Registrar a full report showing as to how the property has been disposed off.

(d). in the event of dissolution of the Society the property and funds of the Society that remain after full satisfaction of the Liabilities of the Society shall be transferred or paid to some other institution with similar aims and objects and which has been recognised by the Income Tax Authorities under the provisions of the Income Tax Act.
